**FIRST THINGS FIRST**

- “The Case for faith” by Lee Strobel. Explores the evidence for the Christian faith including the resurrection of Jesus Christ and the historical accuracy of the bible.
- “Hell’s best kept secret” by Ray Comfort. Available on CD or book. Explores effective witnessing, and advocates showing a person why they need to be saved before how they can be saved.
- “Every Day With Jesus” series by Selwyn Hughes. Booklets that contain daily bible readings, study, suggested prayer, helps and encouragement for believers.
- “Getting the Best out of the Bible” by Selwyn Hughes. A devotional booklet that will help you develop a better daily bible reading habit.
- “The Bondage Breaker” by Neil. T. Anderson.
- “Eternity in their hearts” by Don Richardson. Explores how God has placed a spiritual hunger for himself in people all over the globe.
- “The Jesus I never knew” by Philip Yancey
