A booking has been made again for a 4-night, 3-day gathering at the Vashandiri Centre, Mkoba, Midlands. **Monday night, Sept 13, to Friday morning Sept 17** (with an improved accommodation arrangement).


The purpose of this special gathering is to prayerfully review the past two years, then consider the positioning and relevance of Lifeline as a non-denominational ministry in the changing spiritual environment of the Church in Southern Africa.
