A big surprise was a new development since we were last here with Brian and Jeremy Rensford at the end of September - they left \$US500 from the Australian Lifeline supporters to purchase roofing materials – and by early November, the structure for the new home for the girls was completed!



They had cooked enormous quantities of rice and were enjoying two of their goats and vegetables from the garden that Domingos has set up not far from Sparrow's Nest to provide fresh vegetables year round for the 61 children who now live with them.
